That is the purpose of resolution 312 and I would ask for the body to adopt this resolution. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion on the resolution? If not, the question is the adoption of LR 312. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? If not, and you care to vote, please do so. Have you all voted on resolution number 312? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 312, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The resolution is adopted. We go to resolution 313.

CLERK: Mr. President, 313 is a resolution offered by Senators DeCamp, Pappas and Haberman. It is on page 233 and 234 of the Journal. (Read.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I would like to suggest that some of those members that were concerned about the Curtis school and some of those members who have been reading in the newspapers or speaking directly with Congresswoman Smith maybe pay more than a little attention to this particular issue. As you all know there have been repeated suggestions and fears on the part of some of those interested that the school at Curtis will be closed down, if not this year, then in the not too distant future. There are those of us in here, myself included, that believe the school at Curtis should be preserved and that it serves a very, very important function both in education and in terms of the community and the support system it provides in a community, and that closing it would not be wise and could in fact be fatal to certain parts of the state from an economic standpoint. Congresswoman Smith has apparently gained access to some multimillions of dollars, whether it be 7 or 11 million, I don't know what the final sum will be, if even a penny, and the proposal has been made that new
