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about which committee is going to have which jurisdiction and how many days they are going to be seated, and how they are going to...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...relate to other committees in terms of the subject matter jurisdictions.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That is the second question that comes later. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Barrett, then Senator Schmit, then Senator Vickers, Senator Hoagland, Senator Labedz, Senator Hefner, Senator Sieck, Senator Morehead and Senator Beutler. Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you, Mr. President, members. The other day, last week I had an opportunity to express my concern on this issue at an Executive Board meeting and I particularly liked what Senator Rupp has just mentioned about the elimination of the Constitutional Revision Committee. Since watching and participating in this task force development by the Exec Board and by Senator Morehead and the Rules Committee, I've had a chance to pause and reflect. I am concerned about several areas, I'll touch on just one or two. Constitutional Revisions. I think there is something to be said for one committee being able to sift, sift those constitutional revisions that come before this body. Without that committee, with those responsibilities going to individual committees whose primary responsibilities and interests perhaps are elsewhere, we are liable to have constitutional revisions hitting this floor from 14 or 15 different directions. There is something to be said for a gate, a gate, and to use Senator Rupp's word to sift these issues before they are advanced to this Legislature, by a committee that is solely responsible for that type of work. I would also call your attention to an issue which has not been mentioned, I don't believe, up to this point and that is the matter, if you'll take a look at Format II, of one-day committees. I've had the privilege, and I consider it a privilege, to chair the Business and Labor Committee which is a one-day committee. It's a lot of fun. I've thoroughly enjoyed it. This
