SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, I would like to ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR LAMB: A call of the house has been requested. All those in support vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

Would those gentlemen please report to the Legislative Chamber. One person we are looking for. Would you care to begin the roll, Senator Morehead? Begin the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 249 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion passed. Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, I ask for the adoption of permanent rules for this legislative session.
