

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Barrett, all I want to do is prevent confusion, as I said, so I will withdraw my amendment at this point and then we will talk about it and I will show you exactly what I intend to do, because to be frank, I don't even know right at this instant every place it appears in the bill so I can't respond to it now. That will give me time.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you. I think that solves a potential problem.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, gentlemen. The motion is withdrawn. Is there another?

CLERK: Senator Chambers, you had a second, Senator.

PRESIDENT: There is another Chambers amendment here.

CLERK: On page 7, line 3, you placed a period after the word "insolvent" and struck the remainder of the language through line 5.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Why don't you just hold those amendments and I will let the bill move, and then I will determine whether at this point they should...I meant when we get to Select File they should still be considered.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is withdrawn for the present time. Thank you.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: I simply move the bill be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: The motion is for the bill to advance to Enrollment and Review for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote. The motion is to advance LB 593 from General File to Enrollment and Review for Review. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
