

the original intent of this amendment is still in the committee amendments which is in your bill book. There is very little difference in terms of the two different regulations that I described earlier. Now, your question about the sections. Section 6 is stricken because Section 6 then becomes Section 5. We inserted a new Section 4, as I understand it, and this is done by bill drafters. I didn't do it, but if you'll read Section 7 of the amendment, Section 7 is a repeat of the original Section 6 that's in the bill. Now, it's not our intention to strike Section 6 and take it out. It's back in again and it is done by bill drafters. That's all I can tell you.

SENATOR LAMB: Well, Senator Vickers, I think you've confirmed my fears, that this is not properly drafted, that we really don't know what we're voting on. Which parts of the original bill are being stricken and which parts are being retained and which section now has a new number? I don't think it is clear at all as to what we're doing here.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well then, it's bill drafters' fault, that's all I can say and I'm not blaming bill drafters because we're working the heck out of them, but all I can tell you is that if there is a question in terms of whether the section numbers are correct or not and that I think is the question.

SENATOR LAMB: Well, maybe you could tell me...

SENATOR VICKERS: Probably, E & R could take care of that, but I don't...I can't answer your question.

SENATOR LAMB: Well, Senator Rod indicated that these are really amendments to the original committee amendments which have been rejected. So now are these...I don't understand then, since we rejected the committee amendments, how that these fit into the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Half a minute.

SENATOR LAMB: Well, I'll continue on here if I have a little more time, Mr. Speaker, but I continue to have reservations about the proper form of this amendment. I don't think we're know what we're doing. Beyond that I have reservations about every tank in the state having to be registered with a \$5 fee. I just wonder what we're getting
