

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the A bill was drafted last year and fails to take into account the 3 percent salary increase that has been given to state employees in July 1, 1985. Because it is out of date, it requires your amendment at this point. Revenues generated in '87 from the provisions of this bill are \$250,000. In that year there will be a \$124,000 appropriation to the State Fire Marshal and \$38,000 appropriation to the Department of Environmental Control, and \$62,000, the remainder, if you will, left over for the Department of Environmental Control's emergency clean-up fund. In the year following, those figures go up. There will probably be on Select File a motion to amend because we would anticipate additional federal funds to make our State Fire Marshal expense even less than it is at the figure I have just quoted. But because the A bill is out of date and requires that new numbering, I would move for the adoption of the amendment. I handed it into the Clerk yesterday and I anticipate that it was in the Journal, and perhaps can be found. If not, you will find that the figures are simply 3 percent greater for salary figures than they were last year. That is the only distinction.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the amendment to the A bill. For those that are in the Chamber, if you would return to your seat and vote, I would appreciate it so we could move on. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Landis's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Now back to the A bill.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I move the advancement of LB 217A to Select File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? If not, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
