PRESIDENT: Does that finish your closing? The motion is the adoption of the Pappas amendments to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We're voting on the adoption of the Pappas amendments to the committee amendments. Please record your vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Pappas's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The Pappas amendments are adopted. Now we are back to the committee amendments as amended. Senator Goll, do you wish to speak on the committee amendments?

SENATOR GOLL: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, I have a question for either Senator Johnson or Senator Pappas.

PRESIDENT: Very well.

SENATOR GOLL: Either one. In rural Nebraska we deal with tax supported cemeteries, by and large. There are very few privately owned cemeteries, unless they would be of a particular religious affiliation. We also deal with small town funeral director-embalmer operations. Now, let's assume that I make a deal with the local cemetery district and I purchase my lot and my burial plot is so much money and I buy it and I want to pay for it. So I pay for it because that is the way it is set up. Then I want to cut a deal with the local mortician who...I go in and I sit down and I say I want to purchase and make arrangements for my funeral and interment for myself and my wife. So we go down and we select the box, and we make arrangements for the funeral and the music and the whole bit, and we'll say that that is in Senator Hefner's category, 15 or 20,000 dollars, or two or 3,000, whatever it may be. But let's say it is \$3,000. So I pay the \$3,000. Then let's assume that that mortician either dies, or sells out, or retires and the business in that town and the people that I made my arrangement with cease to operate. Now what happens to me when the time comes? I would presume that on being pronounced dead that I would be sent or picked up by a funeral director from another town who would do the necessary processing. Now what happens to me in my deal that was made 10 years prior? That is my question.
