direction to go? Because, if you do the other way, you mask over the problem, and if the real problem, if the real problem is simply that some of us, maybe me included, haven't been doing our job as chairmen and as committee members, then by simply adding more personnel, more days, more duties, have we not exacerbated the problem? Will it not be even worse in the future? And we'll say, that work load is now four days where it was three before, we've got to change it again. If you fail to deal with the problem, if that's the real problem, then the problem will increase and haunt you more. And I guess I think we've done that in a lot of areas down here in the Legislature. When we couldn't get one particular thing addressed in one particular committee, we simply created another committee. We simply added more personnel. We simply put somebody else duplicating the task and we've done that and you know it. I'm not casting stones at anybody. I'm saying I believe personally that our real problem is internal and that we can handle that internally, that may be slapping a few hands, forcing a few people to take care of their committees a little better, be they John or whoever, deal with it that way rather than masking over the problem. And if we do that, we'll probably see, if anything, a decrease in personnel rather than expansion and we'll probably have a better system rather than simply masking it over and having it come back to haunt us two or three or four years later. I personally believe that is the problem. If you do not believe that is the problem, I can sure understand why you would say, okay, we need to redo the whole system, indeed, indeed for example.

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR DECAMP: Judiciary is now a committee that requires all this additional time and personnel because despite the fact that they did all their major things years ago from criminal code and everything, now, in dealing with these other things, that's more of a work load. If you really believe that, I can understand your sticking with the changes. I say, I personally believe otherwise and I think discipline calls for maintaining the system and then making that system work as it should have in the past.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to reconsider the rule relating to committee structure. That means that a yes vote, green vote, is in favor of Senator DeCamp's side which would
