

this Legislature will permit retrocession to the Winnebago Tribe of jurisdiction over crimes committed on Winnebago land. I am going to support the resolution. Senator Goll has suggested that there are three utterances in the resolution that are not factually correct. And Senator Goll has suggested that those three utterances be excised from the resolution. If, in fact, if, in fact, the removal of those three utterances from the resolution will remove some of the rancor that can surround this issue of retrocession, then I support the removal of those three statements of fact because the gravamen of the resolution does not lie in the preamble. The gravamen of the resolution lies in its actual statement that retrocession is allowed. And for that reason, inasmuch as constituents in Senator Goll's district have taken some offense or some umbrage with these three recitations of fact, I suggest that we go ahead and remove those three recitations of fact and then go about the business of determining whether or not it is proper for this state to cede criminal jurisdiction to the Winnebago Tribe.

PRESIDENT: Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. President and colleagues, I, basically, agree with Senator Johnson. I am quite sure this afternoon after lunch that arguments about state assistance, total tax bill and the gambling issue will be debated much further and also jail standards, et cetera. So at this time, that's all I will say on this one.

PRESIDENT: Very well, the motion is...do you have any closing, Senator Goll? Then the motion is to adopt the Goll amendment, striking of the WHEREASES. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Goll would move to amend by deleting WHEREAS paragraphs 10, 11 and 12 from the amended resolution. (Senator Goll's amendment appears on page 353 of the Legislative Journal.)
