

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: I would like to ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: The motion is for the house to go under call. All those in favor voting aye, those opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

Would you like to wait for them or do you want to go ahead?

SENATOR VICKERS: Are they excused, Madam President?

SENATOR SCOFIELD: No, neither is excused.

SENATOR VICKERS: I guess they are not. I think I would just like to wait.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Okay, we are waiting for Senator Barrett and Senator Wesely. If you are within the sound of my voice, will you please return to the Chamber. Senator Wesely has arrived and we are informed that Senator Barrett is on his way.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 358 of the Legislative Journal.) Madam President, I am going to verify. (Roll call vote verified.) 17 ayes, 19 nays, Madam President.
