But he is willing to take it up on behalf of Senator Beutler who is absent today and it is allowable if you have somebody else to carry the mail for you even though you're not here.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Even though you're not present, you can have someone else take care of a bill like that.

SPEAKER NICHOL: That's right.
