This has no relationship, as far as I am concerned, to the court system and I would urge the body to move the bill over to Select and then at that point we can handle the item of the cost, whether it goes to the clerks, whether it goes to the state or a combination of both. Urge support for the advancement.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Were you through, Senator Barrett? Mr. Clerk, I hear you have an amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner has two motions.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: (No response.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hannibal, are you handling that?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: I don't know anything about that.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Oh.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: What are they?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner is not excused. Senator Hannibal, you have your light on, did you wish to speak while we're waiting for Senator Warner?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. Speaker, yes, I will. I don't know what the amendments are, but I have an idea. I'm going to rise only as a cautionary situation. Senator Hoagland has asked that we move this past General to put it on Select File and I'm going to support that motion, I believe at this point. However, it is important to point out that while the concept I think is a good idea, as Senator Barrett and Senator Hoagland both pointed out, I believe it is a pretty good concept but there is a fiscal impact involved here and it is in the hundreds of thousands of dollars and that is going to have to be worked out. I believe that the sponsors of the bill and the interested parties have agreed that that has to be worked out, so assuming that we can get that worked out to the best interest of our budget situation, I will support it at General File. However, if on Select File we cannot come to an agreement that will make all parties satisfied, that support may linger considerably.
