

SENATOR MARSH: Request to go under call has been made. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR MARSH: The house is under call. Will senators return to their seats and record your presence please. You may accept call ins. I am sorry, Senator Higgins is requesting a roll call vote so we will have a roll call vote. We are looking for Goll, Senator Lamb, Senator Nichol, Senator Pirsch. Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: I would change that to a record vote. I understand that the roll call vote...I would just make it a record vote.

Senator Scofield voting yes. 27 ayes, 10 nays on adoption of committee amendments.
