

you don't take this treatment, you are going to do 30 days. Or if it is a chaplain, if you don't take this treatment, you get 6 months. We know good and well that certain people in this society are not going to be subjected to this heavy punishment. My time is up so I have to pause here.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The time is up on the bill so we will move on. We will not take up the A bill of 631, of course. We will go on to 379. But prior to doing that, while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 57. Mr. Clerk, shall we move on to 379?

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might, yes, sir, right before that, however, a communication from the Governor to the Clerk. (Read communication regarding LB 825. See page 394 of the Legislative Journal.)

Your committee on Public Works whose Chair is Senator Schmit reports LB 309 to General File with committee amendments attached. Senator Goodrich would like to print amendments to 621 in the Journal, Mr. President. (See pages 394-400 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, on LB 379, it was a bill that introduced by Senator Pappas. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 18. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hefner, are you going to take the committee amendments?

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes, Mr. President. Mr. President and members, the committee amendment is just a technical amendment. It inserts "Class A electrical contractors". This was left off in the original bill and I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. If I could have your attention, ladies and gentlemen, let's vote promptly on these amendments that don't require a great deal of discussion. Thank you. Voting on the committee amendments.
