

SENATOR WITHEM: I think just to notify people that in Urban Affairs Committee last year we did have a bill that was brought to us that had this effect and this is not a noncontroversial matter when this gets adopted, which I am probably going to vote to do that, you are probably going to start hearing from a lot of the handicapped groups, those that are genuinely immobile, those who cannot...that are wheelchair bound, that are going to have some concerns about this. So you will be hearing those concerns. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I would only say this, Mr. Chairman, I think it is a reasonable amendment. I think, as Senator Hartnett indicated, it is a minor amount of funds and there are some I think reasons why we can assume that this is not a massive giveaway. I would support the amendment.
