SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, members, this resolution, as read by the Clerk, would simply honor, recognize the service that Norm Hubertus paid to this Legislature serving as its Sergeant-at-Arms and is now enjoying retirement. It seemed appropriate to me that we thank him, officially, for those years of service. I would urge the adoption of LR 323.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Marsh, please.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I, too, rise to support this resolution honoring Norm Hubertus. I have a small story on Norm. I know that last year, when we had the public hearing in the East Chamber on LB 662, as you may remember that Chamber was packed with people on both sides of the issue. At the conclusion of the public hearing it turned out that I was surrounded, fairly quickly, by a number of opponents of 662, and there was a very animated conversation and it got more and more animated. Suddenly, from out of nowhere came Sergeant-at-Arms Norm Hubertus who came to me and gently said, Senator, it is time to go. As he slowly exited me through that crowd I knew, for one moment, the good work of Norm Hubertus as our Sergeant-at-Arms. (Laughter.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. The question is, the adoption of the resolution. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.
