

January 21, 1986 LB 43, 43A, 691

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Record, Mr. Clerk, please. A record vote has been asked for.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 425 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 43A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 43A is a bill offered by Senator Warner. (Title read.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the bill be advanced. It will need an amendment reflecting the current dollar amount that as indicated, the appropriation for '86-87 will be \$67,000 for all the positions and the fiscal note shows the cumulative costs as well as the annual increase from that point forward; 88,000 in '87-88; 42,000, '88-89; 35,000, '89-90 and 13,700, almost 800 in 1990-91. But the A bill of course will only carry the appropriation under the current operating rules for the fiscal year '86-87 that we're appropriating this year and that amount will be \$67,502.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the A bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 43A.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The A bill is advanced. LB 691.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 691 was a bill introduced by Senator DeCamp. (Title read.) The bill was read on January 22 of last year. It was referred to the Banking Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. The bill was considered on March 25. At that time committee amendments were adopted. There was an amendment from Senator DeCamp to the bill that was adopted. There was a motion from Senator Vickers and Beutler to indefinitely postpone the bill. That laid it over, Mr. President. That
