SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Higgins amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Senator Higgins.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, ma'am.

CLERK: Senator, Senators Beutler, Hoagland, Rupp and Schmit.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We're looking for Senators Abboud, Senator Chambers, no, Senator Chronister, Senator Haberman, Senator Hefner, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Lynch, Senator Pirsch, Senator Rogers, Senator Withem.
