SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, four are excused. Senator Goodrich, would you record your presence, please. Thanks. We're looking for Senator Abboud, Senator Haberman. Senator Rod Johnson, would you push your green one, please. Thank you. Senator Abboud, would you record your presence. Now we're looking only for Senator Rex Haberman. Senator Higgins, we're waiting for Senator Haberman only. Would it be all right to go ahead, or do you wish to wait for Senator Haberman?

SENATOR HIGGINS: I'd like to wait for Senator Haberman, if we may.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right.

SENATOR HIGGINS: He is in the building. I understand he was here just a minute ago. I don't like to keep the body waiting. Mr. Speaker, I will only ask for a record vote, not a roll call vote. We could proceed. Senator Haberman is here now.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You want to have call ins authorized then, I assume.

SENATOR HIGGINS: No, I just want a record vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Oh, okay. The question is the adoption of the Higgins amendment and those of you who wish to be on the record vote may indicate so to the Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 448 of the Legislative Journal.) 11 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment fails. Do you have anything else on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President...
