

CLERK: Senator, I have a series of amendments now. Senator Landis, you had amendments, Senator, that were printed last year found on page 847 of the Journal.

SENATOR LANDIS: I wish to withdraw those.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: The next amendment I have, Mr. President, Senator Beutler has amendments that are pending from last year.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is Senator Beutler here? We'll pass over Senator Beutler's amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis has amendments on page 369 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Wish to withdraw those.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would move to amend.

SENATOR LANDIS: This is AM1810, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. There are a couple of wording changes suggested by the bill drafting staff which were borderline E & R amendments and they suggested that since we were adding a few more words and not just simply a numerical change or the like, that I offer these amendments. I gave them to the Clerk today on the hopes that they would be able to be published before tomorrow, however, let me tell you what they say. In addition to the word "fee" we have the language "or commission" as a result of the contract and then in another place a connecting language "with the business involved in the contract." These are technical amendments offered by the bill drafting staff and since we're not only adding to "fee" the definition "or commission as a result of the contract", there was a request from them that we do this on the floor. I would move the adoption of these technical amendments to LB 548.
