PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not the motion is to advance LB 548 from General File. All those in favor vote aye...excuse me, from Select File to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 548 is advanced. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT: The call of the house is raised. Speaker Nichol, do you wish recognition?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr President, members of the Legislature, just a short speech to you. You have a notification on your desk that is of bold print that I hope you will look at. If you'd like, make a copy of it and take it to your office. It merely says that the priority bills of senators and committees, so committee chairmen please take note also, February 18. That is not very far away, a couple of weeks, maybe a little bit more than a couple of weeks. I have moved that up about four working days from where it ordinarily is. The purpose of this was so that we can get to some of them inasmuch as if it takes as much this year to handle the appropriation and revenue bills as it did last year, then we will be needing to do your priority bills ahead of many bills that come up in their regular order.
