

CLERK: Senator Schmit, any of your amendments, Senator, do you want on the bill?

SENATOR SCHMIT: No, none of them.

PRESIDENT: Those amendments are withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Johnson, Rod Johnson, okay, note to withdraw. Senator Lamb, you had one additional amendment.

PRESIDENT: There is an amendment pending on the bill, so I guess maybe we'll have to leave it in its present position. Senator Schmit, do you want to take the chance to move the bill and then...

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 284 from Select File to Enrollment and Review for Engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. You want to move the A bill, too, Senator? Senator Schmit, do you wish to move the A bill also?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move that 284A be advanced, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 284A from Select File. Is there discussion? If not, all those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried, the bill is advanced. Is there anything further for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further for the record, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall, we'll entertain a motion to recess...or adjourn I guess.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that we adjourn until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.

PRESIDENT: Just a minute. Thank you. One more thing for the record.

CLERK: Excuse me, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: That's all right.
