

this state, I don't care what you do with the amendment. It makes me no difference at all. There are far more important things that I ought to be giving my time to. And I am going to encourage those people who are going to have their meeting tomorrow to find an alternate site and I definitely will be there and the tone of my talk will be a lot different from what it would have been because as circumstances change, tactics and responses have to change. Before, there would have been a kind of academic or informative discussion.

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now a challenge has been made in this state to the right of people to assemble and express their point of view. To prevent that from occurring before anything wrong happens is known as prior restraint. But nobody other than myself will take issue with it because we know the group that is responsible and that group has power and there are people even afraid to mention the name of that group.

PRESIDENT: You have five more minutes to introduce your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, I see. The Antidefamation League is one of the groups and they have been very busy. At the same time, they had gone out into western Nebraska and told them that Jews are not interested in causing problems for farmers, that they are not the ones who are causing foreclosures. But I wonder what those farmers and others out in western Nebraska, who were going to attend this meeting, will think when they were denied the right to even assemble and speak. We are living in perilous times in this state. John F. Kennedy said, those who make peaceful evolution impossible, make violent revolution inevitable. Senator Barrett, I am not going to take any more time talking because it is your bill and I don't want to hinder a vote from being taken on it. But as far as the amendment is concerned, I don't care what you do with it.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, when Senator Chambers mentioned to me yesterday he was going to offer this amendment, it seemed like it was
