PRESIDENT: Do you wish to speak on the amendment, Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will let that one go. (Inaudible.)

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: DeCamp is excused.

CLERK: I have two amendments and they are both from Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, are you available to take up your amendments? Does someone...anyone else to take up Senator DeCamp's amendments? We will stand by it until he comes back. What further amendments do you have, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett, what do you wish to do?

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President, I move that the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 593. It is debatable. Is there discussion? If not, all those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting to advance the bill from Select File to Enrollment and Review for Engrossing. Voting to advance the bill. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Do you have matters for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senators Nichol and Pappas would like to print amendments to LB 32. (See page 512 of the Legislative Journal.)
