

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call. Now will members again look up to the board and record your presence, please. Members outside the Chamber, please return to the Legislative Chamber. The house is under call. Members are properly to be in your seats during the time the house is under call. Senator Abboud. Senators Chronister and Conway. Senators Goodrich and Haberman, Harris and Hartnett. Senator Lynch, please. Senator Pappas, Senator Schmit, Senator Smith. Will those names please come into the Legislative Chamber and record your presence. How do you wish to proceed, call in votes?

SENATOR WITHEM: We had better have a roll call, I think.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Senator Goodrich, Senator Schmit. Senators Goodrich and Schmit, please report to the Legislative Chamber. The house is under call. A roll call vote has been requested. The house is under call. Senator Goodrich, please return to the Chamber. Senator Goodrich, your presence is requested on the floor of the Legislature. Senator Withem, Senator Goodrich is the only one we can't seem to locate at the moment. Should we proceed?

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, let's go ahead.

PRESIDENT: Motion is the adoption of the Schmit amendment. May we have quiet in the Chamber please. (Gavel.) The Clerk will call the roll. Please vote aye or nay. Excuse me, on the Withem amendment, excuse me.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Withem. This amendment is on page 158 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The call of the house is raised.

SENATOR WITHEM: Pass over that amendment, we will just debate the bill.
