

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance...

SENATOR HALL: Maybe we can take out this 25-page technical amendment in E & R.

PRESIDENT: You have the great power as Chairman of E & R to do that, I guess.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 599 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced. Anything for the record at this time, Mr. Clerk? Very well. We will move on to General File, LB 124. (Gavel.)

CLERK: Mr. President, 124 was considered...well, first of all, Mr. President, it is a bill by Senator Rod Johnson. (Read title.) It was introduced last year, referred to the Public Works Committee. The bill was advanced to General File without amendment. It was considered on January 17 of this year, Mr. President. At that time there was a motion made to indefinitely postpone by Senators Beutler and Wesely. That is now pending, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. President and members, this was up on consent calendar and I raised the issue then. Senator Beutler had a kill motion and we passed over it, then I co-signed with Senator Beutler. Now, evidently Senator Beutler would like to not get involved. I would like to suggest that we kill LB 124, not so much because Senator Johnson is wrong in proposing the measure, but
