CLERK: The Hoagland amendment is still pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hoagland's amendment is pending. Do you want to...Senator Higgins, do you wish to speak on the amendment?

SENATOR HIGGINS: (Microphone not activated)...bit.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Anything further? Senator Hoagland. The motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Hoagland to LB 631A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on an amendment to LB 631A offered by Senator Hoagland. Please record your vote. The Chair would ask the cooperation of the membership to expedite our agenda this morning. Please record your vote on the Hoagland amendment. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Now do we have just the bill? Another amendment.

CLERK: No, I have another motion.

PRESIDENT: Another motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Higgins would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to indefinitely postpone. Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: I think everyone here knows when the bill was discussed I asked some legitimate questions of Senator Hoagland. I had an appointment at eleven forty-five. I stayed. I listened to the debate. I made a motion to adjourn. It is the first time I can remember when a motion to adjourn, when anyone yelled out, no, because it was very close to twelve o'clock, and I had someone waiting in my office since eleven forty-five and it was at that time, probably about eleven forty-nine or fifty, the A bill I thought could have been taken up tomorrow or the next day and certainly would fly.
