

accumulate to the county. As a practical matter it is a revenue raiser to the county because their cost will not equal the fee either. The last time that I recall that we were involved in, at least I had any contact with changing these rates, I think was in '82 when we had a number of fees that were increased in 1982 including the marriage license. It was adjusted later because of some tests that were eliminated. But it was done then as a revenue measure and I offer the amendment solely for the reason that if the bill is enacted as it is it reduces receipts of the General Fund by \$116,000. The amendment is offered to preserve that. With the amendment the counties still get the \$10 for doing the work and that's a money raiser for them too.
