

fleet, that does constitute product ethanol as part of the fuel gasohol. Now primarily this would be sort of an economic development program that the Department of Education can participate in. There is no new funds required. It is just a designation of those funds that the schools get and designating a portion of them for rebate for ethanol. The only way any real change would occur in the schools is those schools that do not use ethanol in their vehicles would have that portion less in their fund. Those schools that probably don't get equalization right now would get a small rebate for the use of this fuel. There would be an A bill come out on this that I understand will be in the amount of about \$14,000 for administration of this program. I feel that, with a l of the talk and activity that we have on economic development and some of the more major programs that are being proposed, that this is one small token program that could be gotten underway, and it would expand the base of our economic development to where our school systems can also help in promoting a Nebraska product. I would urge the advancement of this bill.
