PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the bill is advanced.
LB 871.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 871 was introduced by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. (Read.) The bill was referred to your Committee on Miscellaneous Subjects. They report the bill back to General File without committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move for the advancement of LB 871. This bill is the result of the interim study that the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee held this summer and fall. It repeals the two sections in the Liquor Control Act that have been ruled unconstitutional by the State Supreme Court. The first section that it repeals, where it says, "no more than two liquor licenses can be held in the State of Nebraska," and the other section that it repeals is that the sections that described, in the law, that more than two licenses could be held, like for instance an eating place, or a motel, or something like that. I move for the advancement of this bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the bill? If not, the motion is to advance LB 871. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is to advance LB 871. Please record your vote. May we have the attention of the membership to the motion on the floor, please. Record your vote on the advancement of LB 871. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The motion to advance carries and the bill is advanced. Do you have, at this time, matters for the record, Mr. Clerk? Very well. That completes the consent calendar of bills with no committee amendments. Now we proceed into bills with committee amendments. LB 512. Is there a point, Senator Haberman?
