Mr. President, I have unanimous consent requests, the first is from Senator Hall to add his name to LB 71; and Senator Warner would like unanimous consent to hold the public hearings of the Appropriations Committee for the month of February in Room 2414 of the State Capitol Building.

PRESIDENT: No objections, so ordered. Does that finish the matters to be read?

CLERK: That is all that I have, Mr. President, yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: We have now LR 332.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 332 was offered by Senator Goll. It is found on page 592 of the Journal. (Read.) Mr. President, Senator Goll would move to amend the resolution. I assume you want to take that up now, Senator. And that amendment is: (Read amendment offered by Senator Goll found on page 609 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Goll.

SENATOR GOLL: Mr. President and ladies and gentlemen of the Legislature, this is a small correction in the resolution and I would request that you adopt the resolution or the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the amendment? If not, all those in favor of the amendment to the resolution vote aye, opposed vote nay. The amendment appears to be correctional, Senator, is that correct?

SENATOR GOLL: That is correct, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We are voting on a correctional amendment, a minor correctional amendment to resolution 332. Please record your vote. Please record your vote on the amendment to Senator Goll's resolution. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Goll's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. (Gavel.) May we have order in the Chamber, please. The Chair recognizes Senator Goll.
