PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Haberman amendment. We are on Select File, 25 votes required. All those in favor of the Haberman amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please vote, if you wish to vote, on the Haberman amendment. The Chair will allow 30 seconds for the recording of the vote, please. The motion before you is the Haberman amendment to LB 626. If you wish to vote, please record your vote. Fifteen seconds to record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The amendment is not adopted. Do you have matters for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir, I do not.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Barrett.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I move we adjourn until tomorrow, February 4, at 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The motion is to adjourn until 9:00 a.m. tomorrow morning. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The Legislature is adjourned.
