

SENATOR DECAMP: All the pieces are there for the destruction of this factory, because if you destroy those first pieces, you have destroyed the final piece, and the final piece is the processing plants. Now I am going to hand out copies of material I obtained from the Economic Development Office under pressure and force and everything else, I just got them. The Governor said he didn't know of any incidents where Initiative 300 had hurt the state. Read through the letters. They have them on file there. They have them on file documenting one after another the damage. You have got one big feed yard that they can't even move, Grosserode, because of Initiative 300 right now. You will have more. I hope we can discuss this in some depth. Senator Hefner said, my goodness, we are going to spend hours talking about this Initiative 300 if we revive it. For God's sake, people, what issue affects the future of the state more than the whole agricultural economy and this is the life or death of the agricultural economy.

PRESIDENT: Your time is expiring.

SENATOR DECAMP: I hope I can talk more on this and I hope we all will. If ever there was something to discuss, it is the economy of the state, and if ever there was the economy of the state at stake, it is because of Initiative 300 one way or the other.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, I rise to oppose the motion to reconsider. I would point out to you that of those who have spoke so far, I am probably the only one that has something on the outside of my boots occasionally that you don't get in here on the outside at least. That has nothing to do with the issue because it is a divided issue out there and I understand that. Senator DeCamp says that he thinks those who are opposed to reconsideration ought to talk substance. Well, let's talk substance for a little bit. Senator DeCamp talked about the cow-calf industry. Senator Harris mentioned Pawnee Springs Ranch and its 90,000 acres. Well, I can tell you that Pawnee Springs Ranch is not just one ranch. There are three different ranches that make up Pawnee Springs Ranch and they are being operated right now by individuals, and if anybody thinks that there aren't enough capital available, or at
