CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the house is under call. All members in the Chamber, please look up to the front board and see that your presence light is on, please. Members throughout the Capitol Building, members of the Legislature, the house is under call and you are requested to come to the Senate Chamber and record your presence. There is a motion on the floor to advance LB 667 and your presence is requested on the floor of the Legislature. The house is under call. Senator Wesely, Senator Baack. Senator Harris is approaching his desk. Senator Morehead. I believe we have established that all members are here who are not excused. Now we will have order in the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) Senator Higgins is recognized to make a closing on her bill, LB 667.
