How are your constituents going to feel about this? Did they ask you to support this, or was it a special interest group? I, personally, do not want to have this blood and this death on my hands or my mind, so I urge you to vote no or to pass on LB 626. Mr. President, I withdraw my kill motion, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Motion is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have on the bill is by Senator Hoagland. Senator Hoagland would move to suspend the rules...withdraw that. Mr. President, the next motion I have is by Senator Chambers. (Read Chambers amendment found on page 643 of the Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I would like you to turn, if you have any interest in this, to...Mr. Clerk, would you read that...the location of that amendment again. I know what it is, but I want to show them in the book where it is.

CLERK: Senator, the one I have is page 13, strike lines 23 through 26.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If you look at this, I will read the language that I am striking. "The applicant is self-employed and can prove that loss of the ability to drive a motor vehicle will prohibit or seriously impair such applicant's ability to continue such employment." I say that if the purpose of this bill is to preserve the employment of people who have one conviction for driving under the influence, then everybody situated in those circumstances should gain the benefit of the bill and here is what I mean. Anybody whose job requires him or her to drive should be allowed to gain the benefits of this bill.
