So taking it to mean like people ordinarily take it who don't understand things like that, where are you, they won't have to ask where I am on this bill. I shall be here. I hate to say it, Madam Chairman, Madam Chairperson, but I think they said Roosevelt was one who said, I hate war, my wife hates war, my dog hates war. The same can be said for this bill, except that I no longer have a wife and I don't have a dog. But if I had them, they would hate this bill too.
