

SENATOR LAMB: Roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call by that motion which has carried. Members in your seats, please look up to the board and see that your presence light is on. Members, please record your presence. And members outside the Legislative Chamber, please return, the house is under call. Your presence is requested on the floor of the Legislature. We are about to undertake a roll call vote on the Lamb amendment to LB 796. Senator Baack, record your presence, please, Senator. Senators Chambers and Chizek, Conway and Eret. Senators Hefner and Rod Johnson. Senator Labeledz and Senator Harold Sieck. Will those members please record your presence. If you're outside the Chamber, please return to the Senate Chamber, the house is under call. Unauthorized personnel are to remove themselves from the floor of the Legislature. Members are properly to be in your seats and you're doing that. Thank you. Senator Hefner, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Labeledz. Senator Labeledz, Rod Johnson. Senator Rod Johnson, please return to the Chamber. Senator Rod Johnson is the only one missing. Senator Johnson is on his way. Senator Lamb, we are informed that Senator Johnson is on his way. Shall we proceed? Members, please give us your attention. (Gavel.) You're about to vote on the Lamb amendment to LB 796. A roll call vote has been requested. The Clerk will call the roll, aye or nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 668 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 29 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is not adopted. The next matter on the desk, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill at this time.
