

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the return of the bill for the Vickers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? We should be in our seats, incidentally, ladies and gentlemen, so that we can see who is here. Have you all voted? Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Well, Mr. President, I hate to do it but I guess I'll have to ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, we are under call. What you may request is...

SENATOR VICKERS: Okay, well I want everybody to punch in and roll call vote then.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Will you please record your presence. Six are excused. While you are registering your attendance, may I please introduce some guests of Senator Hannibal in the north balcony. We have 20 eighth graders from Wagner School in Boys Town, accompanied by their teacher. Would you folks please stand and be recognized. Thank you for visiting us today. Have you all recorded your presence? We're looking for Senator Conway, Senator Goodrich, Senator Haberman, Senator Hannibal, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Landis, Senator Lynch. Senator Carsten has requested call in votes be accepted. Senator Vickers, did you ask for a roll call vote? Okay, we'll have a roll call vote then as soon as we get here. We're looking for Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Haberman. We're looking for Senator Haberman yet. Senator Haberman is here now. Roll call is on the return of the bill for a specific amendment, and that amendment is the Vickers amendment. So we'll have a roll call, Mr. Clerk, on the return of the bill. (Gavel.) We have a roll call and the Clerk can't hear the response, so will you hold it down, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote commenced.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: (Gavel.) Please hold it down so the Clerk can hear your response. Thank you.

CLERK: (Finished taking roll call vote. See page 699 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.
