SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill...LB 172 passes without the emergency clause. May I please introduce some guests of Senator Shirley Marsh. She has 45 friends of the Nebraska Commission on the Status of Women from all across the state. They are in the south balcony. Are you all in the south balcony, or are some of you in the north balcony? Wherever you are, please stand up and be recognized. Thank you, ladies. We'll move on to LB 301, please.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 301 passes. LB 593 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all on 593 I do have amendments from Senator DeCamp that were filed last year.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I understand he wishes to withdraw. Is there anyone that objects to the withdrawal of those amendments? I see none. They are withdrawn. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?
