CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 705 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 8 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 643 passes. LB 643A.

CLERK: (Read LB 643A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 706 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 8 nays, 2 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 643A passes. We'll move on to LB 7, or I mean number 7, the motions.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nichol would move to suspend Rule 6, Section 7(b) to permit consideration of LB 988 today.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? The question is the suspension of the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays to suspend the rules to read the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay the rules are suspended. You may read the bill, please.

CLERK: (Read LB 988 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 988 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The bill has the emergency clause on, which I should have stated. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 707 of the Legislative
