please leave the legislative floor and will all members please be in your seats so that we may commence Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, will you please commence Final Reading on LB 74.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on LB 74. Senator Pappas would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. (Read Pappas amendment found on page 714 of the Journal.)

SENATOR GOLL: The Chair recognizes Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. Speaker, colleagues, we inadvertently forgot to put an effective date on this bill and that is why I asked to bring it back so we can put an effective date, so we know exactly who it covers, so we do not cause any great problems or misinterpretation of the bill. I ask this body to return the bill.

SENATOR GOLL: Is there any further discussion on Senator Pappas's motion to return the bill for a specified amendment? There are no objections so we will proceed to vote on the motion to return the bill. All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, or opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SENATOR GOLL: The bill is returned. Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. Speaker, colleagues, I ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR GOLL: Is there any discussion? All in favor say (sic) aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR GOLL: Senator Pappas, would you move to readvance the bill.

SENATOR PAPPAS: I move to readvance the bill.

SENATOR GOLL: We'll take this by voice vote. All in favor
