SENATOR LYNCH: I move the amendment, Mr. Chairman.

SENATOR GOLL: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, we will proceed to vote on the Lynch amendment. All in favor say (sic) aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return...or adopt the amendment, excuse me.

SENATOR GOLL: The motion is adopted. Senator Lynch, do you wish to readvance your bill?

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes. Mr. Chairman, I move to advance the bill to General...to Final Reading again.

SENATOR GOLL: This will be a voice vote. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried. Mr. Clerk, will you proceed with Final Reading on LB 595E.

CLERK: (Read LB 595 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR GOLL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 595E pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 716 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
