

February 10, 1986 LB 578, 595, 599, 621

SENATOR GOLL: LB 595 passes with the emergency clause. Before we continue, I would like to announce that guests of Senator Baack, from Harrisburg, Nebraska, are under the north balcony. Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Griffiths. We welcome you to the halls of government, Mr. and Mrs. Griffith. Mr. Clerk, will you proceed with Final Reading. LB 599E.

CLERK: (Read LB 599 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR GOLL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 599 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have all voted who desire to vote? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 717 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

SENATOR GOLL: LB 599 passes with the emergency clause. Mr. Clerk, before you proceed, it is my pleasure to announce that guests of Senator Remmers are in the north balcony, six high school students from Nemaha Valley with their instructor. Welcome to the halls of government, teacher and students. Mr. Clerk, proceed with Final Reading. LB 621.

CLERK: (Read LB 621 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR GOLL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 621 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 717-18 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR GOLL: LB 621 passes. Before we begin, may I say that I had a call from one of our colleagues who tells me that they are having a little difficulty reading the score board because of the glare, the glare that is coming from up here. I thought if it is troublesome, I would be glad to send in for my hat. (Laughter.) LB 578. Mr. Clerk, I understand there is an amendment.
