That is signed by Senator Rupp. And your Committee on Health and Human Services, whose Chair is Senator Wesely, reports LB 921 to General File with amendments, and 926 to General File with amendments, those signed by Senator Wesely as Chair. Mr. President, LR 335 was a resolution offered by Senators DeCamp and Conway. It is found on page 645 of the Journal. The Legislature last considered it on February 6. At that time, Mr. President, Senator Landis had a motion to amend. Senator Pappas had moved to amend the Landis amendment. That had prevailed. I had pending, Mr. President, at the time we left the resolution, an amendment to the Landis amendment from Senator Scofield. That is found on page 683 of the Journal.
