CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner's report is found on page 720 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move for the approval of the Governor's appointment to two members to the Arts Council. The first one is Susan K. Renken. Susan is from Imperial, Nebraska, Senator Haberman's District, or the town where he comes from. She is employed by a bank in Enders, Nebraska, very interested in art work in Nebraska, and would like to have the Legislature approve her as a member of the Arts Council. The other one that I am happy to present this morning is Willie L. Sapp who is an arts teacher in East High in Lincoln. He is very interested in the arts in Nebraska and so at this time I move that we accept those as the Governor's appointments to the Arts Council.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the appointment confirmation report? If not, the motion is to confirm the appointments that Senator Hefner has mentioned. All those in favor of the confirmation report vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the confirmation report of appointees to the Nebraska Arts Council. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the confirmation report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation report is approved. The appointments are confirmed. Senator Marsh would have us welcome a special guest of hers this morning who is under the south balcony.
