The books cannot be taken off the shelves. So when you begin to talk about expressing ideas, it is a very touchy area, but because you have been sold a bill of goods and made to believe that this will apply only to hate groups, and yet you have defined none of those groups in this bill, then you are indeed being sold a bill of goods, and this bill can go far beyond anything that anybody on this floor has represented this bill as doing. When Senator Higgins said she was following the common sense approach, a lot of times when you deal with legal and legislative issues, common sense turns out, unfortunately, to be nonsense.
