I want Senator Remmers to know for sure while he is in favor of making this statement that he is creating a crime that can be used to prosecute a person just for what he or she teaches without any illegal act resulting. The illegality is in what somebody divines your intent to be. So in order that we know where we are, I am going to ask...Mr. Clerk, excuse me, would you just read the amendment that is offered as it is drafted.

CLERK: Page 3, line 5 strike the word "knows".
