Chambers amendment? The Chair will allow 15 seconds for you to record your vote. Please record your vote. The motion is to cease debate on the Chambers amendment. Time for voting is rapidly expiring. Have you all voted who wish to vote? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and Senator Chambers is recognized to...Senator Chambers, let me make announcements first please that have been requested. Senator Higgins has a guest in the Chamber today, her husband, Dave Higgins, and he is accompanied by nephew Bob and Pat Caudel from Bismark, North Dakota, and Mr. Caudel has a unique office in that he is Vice President of a state owned bank in North Dakota, the only state owned bank in the country. Welcome to the Nebraska Legislature. The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Mr. Chairman, what I have to do on that amendment is add the word "or". The amendment should read, I am striking the words "knows or".

PRESIDENT: Just making a substitution and keeping the present amendment up there.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, because if this should carry, then the word "or" should not be retained.

PRESIDENT: Is there objection to having a substitution? If not, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator, please, would you...I am sorry, I wasn't paying attention. Tell me again.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, sure, that is all right. In line 5, the current language said "when such person knows or has reason...", the way I drafted the amendment, it just struck "knows". The word "or" should be stricken also.

CLERK: Knows or, okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right.

CLERK: Thank you, Senator.
