So when there develops very serious problems in the rural areas, as I assure you they will develop, you are putting law enforcement officers in a position not to prevent what happened to Arthur Kirk but to make it easier, to make it easier to go onto people's land under circumstances when they cannot do it now. They would have to have probable cause that a crime is being committed and go to a judge and get a warrant if they don't observe something that is a crime, and if people are inside their homes, this creates a great gap in the Constitution because you are creating a new crime and this new crime will enable law enforcement officers to obtain warrants under circumstances when they couldn't and go into people's homes and onto private property because you have created a new crime. And all the officers have to do is allege that this crime has been committed, and what is the crime? Not a civil disorder, not participating in a disorder, not encouraging a disorder, but teaching things that somebody else who is in law enforcement says that the people listening to will use in a civil disorder even if no civil disorder occurs. That is the kind of atrocious trash that this bill is. Watts Trucking Company ought to be down here to deal with this, they are the ones who pick up the trash in Omaha, and get every copy of this and haul it away. And when that day comes and problems develop, and farmers are talking about what the law enforcement persons are doing to them, coming onto their property, harassing them at meetings, then some of you who vote for this bill will probably say, well, they can't do that.
