benefit of that conservation program. It is a serious issue, one that I think this Legislature ought to be aware of. I urge your adoption of this resolution to try to urge the Congress to protect the resources of our country that are in actual food production, and also those people who because of the economic situation that they find themselves in will not be able to compete and, therefore, receive the funds for soil conservation under the other program. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the resolution 342? If not, the motion is to adopt the resolution as explained by Senator Vickers. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: LR 342 is adopted. Next we move to motions. LR 19.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Withem would move to withdraw LR 19.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Mr. President, members of the body, LR 19 was a constitutional amendment introduced last year. Due to some logistical problems, the hearing on it was postponed and then ultimately cancelled, held over for this year. Getting this late in the session it seems kind of pointless for us to try to deal with a bill that was introduced last year, hasn't even had a hearing yet. So I'm asking that it be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is to withdraw LR 19. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to withdraw the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, the bill...the resolution is withdrawn. LB 792, motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to place
